In addition to the main duty of welcoming all who enter our doors, volunteers will:

- Give information to visitors about the history and architecture of the building, the parish and its activities
- Provide assistance accessing services, filling out forms, and placing local telephone calls as requested
- Provide light refreshments as donations permit
- Provide friendly listening to visitors
- Support the Toronto Homeless Memorial, 2nd Tuesday of the month
- Provide a safe welcoming environment for refuge from the weather
